Once again, January is just a few days away. We all know the routine, the drill, the expectation...resolutions. Good? Bad? Indifferent? Have you given thought to Spiritual Resolutions? The newness, freshness & excitement of 2020 is the perfect impetus for making positive changes in your journey of faith, your walk with God! Here's my 1<sup>st</sup> two suggestions for Spiritual Resolutions.

1) Increase your Marian Devotion. This year marks the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary to the 3 shepherd children of Fatima, Portugal.
