FAITH FORMATION

This past week, Fr. Kerner celebrated his 48th Anniversary of his Ordination into the Priesthood, the Sacrament of Holy Orders. Holy Orders belongs to the Sacraments at the Service of Communion. This means they are primarily directed toward the salvation of others. The recipients of this Sacrament grow in holiness through their service to others.

Ordination to the priesthood is always a call and a gift from God reserved for baptized males. For entry into the seminary, these men should be 25 — 55 years of age, unmarried, in good standing & active in the Catholic Church, and may have a college degree and life experiences. These men, chosen by God, answer his call with the words of the prophet Isaiah "Here I am, send me." (Isaiah 6:8) Ordained priests exercise their service to others by teaching, divine worship and pastoral governance. Their many roles are fulfilled through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on them. Let us continue to pray for all the priests of our lives...from the one who baptized us, gave us our First Communion, confirmed us, married us, and the one that will one day bury us.

You are invited to join us for a 5 week mini-course on Native American history and culture, our call to mission and discernment.

WHY IT IS IMPORTANT TO REGISTER AT A PARISH

Question:

Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Answer:

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.




