


This past weekend, Tony received the blessing from Fr. Kerner in the Rite of Sending. This means that he is being “sent with Father & the entire parish’s blessing” to the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament next weekend. With Archbishop Vigneron presiding, the Rite of Election will be conducted for the catechumens (those not yet baptized) and candidates throughout the Archdiocese. This wonderful moment in our Catholic faith never fails to touch one’s heart and I thank Tony and Shawn for allowing me to accompany them on this journey. Please continue to pray for Tony, Shawn and all the catechumens and candidates and their sponsors throughout our Archdiocese and the world.



Adult Confirmation Sessions will be hosted at St. Kateri beginning on Thursday, April 23rd from 7 PM to 9 PM. Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.
