

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

You have probably heard on the news that the Archdiocese of Detroit has issued some guidelines for churches as we seek to look after the health and safety of worshipers. Some of these St. Kateri has already implemented. We have discouraged the shaking of hands at the greeting of peace. We also have suspended offering the Precious Blood at Communion. With further concern the Archdiocese has recommended the emptying and cleaning of holy water fonts. (Actually in this season of Lent the precaution can also be symbolic of our preparation for the blessing of the Easter water on Holy Saturday and the refilling of all fonts. Hopefully by Easter we will be over the need for precautions.) Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Unless you feel ill and are experiencing cold and flu symptoms there is no reason to fear coming to church for our various Lenten liturgies and activities. We still plan to have our annual Irish Stew dinner on March 14th, Family Faith Formation classes and all other meetings and classes. Common sense should always dictate your decisions.

Try to do all the things that health officials recommend and don't forget to say a prayer for all the folks on our prayer list. Have a healthy week!

From Our Archbishop

Dear Fathers, Devoted Religious, and Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It is with great joy and thanksgiving to the Lord that I share with you the news that our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has granted the title of Minor Basilica to Ste. Anne Church in Detroit. To mark this blessed occasion, I am glad to have been invited by Monsignor Kosanke to celebrate Mass at 12 p.m. on Sunday, April 26 in praise to God for this honor.

At its founding on the Feast of St. Anne in 1701, this parish was among the first fruits of a new missionary diocese. I consider the church's designation as a basilica to be a providential reminder that today, we each are called to continue this same mission to unleash the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the men and women of our time.

I hope, too, that this recognition will raise up for all of us - clergy, religious and faithful - the treasure the parishioners of Ste. Anne already hold close to their hearts: their devotion to St. Anne, patroness of their parish and of the Archdiocese of Detroit. I am confident that in embracing this designation as a basilica, we will be inspired to rediscover and renew the friendship we have always had with \$t. Anne, and have confidence knowing that we can always run to this holy shrine to ask for her intercession.

We are truly blessed by the Holy Father's recognition of Ste. Anne's historic significance to the City of Detroit and our local Church.

FAITH FORMATION

On Saturday, February 29th, our parishioner, Tony Lara, was one over 800 candidates and catechumens in the Archdiocese to celebrate the Rite of Election. The Rite of Election was celebrated by Bishop Hanchon at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament. Tony's desire and resolve to be initiated into the sacramental life of the Church was supported by the testimony of his wife, Shawn. Now considered one of the Elect, Tony will continue his journey of preparation to the Easter Vigil when he will be fully initiated into the Catholic Church. Please continue to keep Tony & Shawn and all of the Elect around the world in your prayers as they enter into this season of Lent.



Towel Sunday Collection begins next weekend, March 14th and continues until through Sunday, April 5th. We are in need of new pillows, pillowcases, blankets (full and twin size), sheets (full and twin), and towel sets as well as toiletries, feminine hygiene products, incontinence items, diapers, baby wipes, household cleaning products, disinfecting wipes, and powdered laundry detergent. We are no longer unable to accept gently <u>used items</u>. Baskets for the collection will be located at the entrances to the church and the hall. This year's recipients will be Nativity of Our Lord Parish, Freedom House, and Workers' House (Day House). If you are interested in sorting or delivering these items on Monday, April 6th, please contact the parish office.

Adult Confirmation Sessions will be hosted at St. Kateri beginning on Thursday, April 23rd from 7 PM to 9 PM. These sessions are for any adult, baptized in the Catholic faith, who has received 1^{st} Eucharist but has not received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Sessions are for six weeks and culminate with the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament on Pentecost Sunday. Cost is \$10.00. 
