#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This Tuesday evening I will be meeting with a group of very dedicated parishioners who will have a concerted and dedicated role in implementing our parish response to emergency situations. They include our sacristans, parish staff, weekly on site volunteers and pastoral council members. These folks are NOT intended to be "first responders" but rather "cool heads" knowing what to do in situations that require awareness and calm leadership. They are your fellow parishioners that you see in church and probably even know their names. Speaking for all of us parishioners of St. Kateri I want to applaud all who do so much for us behind the scenes.

The plan will be rolled out in October to all parishioners and is already available in all the vestibules of our parish buildings. Not unlike what you find in a hotel room, the protocols for emergencies are spelled out. Intended primarily for visitors. I encourage you to pay attention to them as well. You will be given your own copy in the weeks ahead. All our efforts are intended NOT to frighten but rather enlighten you and give you confidence in the health and safety of our parish environment. My gratitude to the members of our committee who helped over the summer to develop and create the procedures for a safe environment at St. Kateri.

This coming Sunday, September 29<sup>th</sup>, our parish trip to Gettysburg, Washington D.C. and Pittsburgh begins. Thirty-three of us will enjoy the multiple historic sites that each venue offers. A special visit will be made to Shanksville, PA where Flight 93 crashed on September 11, 2001. It is a sacred place with a significant recognition and memorial commemorating the first act of anti-terrorism staged by Americans. The trip was designed to enable an appreciation of our historic, religious and patriotic heritage. I think all will enjoy the adventure!

Staying home will be many pets awaiting their annual St. Francis Animal blessing. Plan on bringing your furry friend(s) to the back porch of the Parish Center (check the building floor plan in the vestibule) on Sunday, October 6 at 12:30 PM. Our holy Deacon will be waiting with the holy water! Have a great first week of autumn.


