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Day 1

This morning we begin our adventure to French Canada with a cup of hot coffee and a snack served by a professional Bianco Tour Director. After stopping at the **Duty Free** and taking some rest stops, one of which will be for lunch on our own, we arrive in Kingston, Ontario, our home for the night. Dinner is included at the Harbour Restaurant located at the site of the 1976 Olympics with magnificent views of Lake Ontario and the ambiance of the sailing basin. After dinner, we check into the Ambassador Hotel for the night.

Day 2

Following an included breakfast this morning, we depart for Quebec City. Dinner at **Erabliere le Chemin du Roy** offers us an unique French Canada experience. We'll have an all-you-can-eat hearty meal served family style while we enjoy traditional live entertainment. Following the meal, we enjoy a Quebec tradition of Maple Taffy on snow made with maple syrup tapped from the very trees surrounding the area. This evening, we check into the Holiday Inn Express in Quebec City, our home for the next two nights.

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Day 3

Another included breakfast greets us this morning before we embark on a **tour of Quebec City** with a local step-on-guide. See the beautiful sites of the capital of the Province of Quebec including the St. Lawrence River, Joan of Arc Gardens, Parliament, Old Town and much more! This afternoon, we will visit **Montmorency Falls** where we take a cable car to the top of the mountain for an included lunch and time to view the magnificent falls. Higher than Niagara Falls, Montmorency Falls stand 272 feet tall and plunge down to the St. Lawrence River below. After some time to relax at the hotel, we visit **Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupre Shrine** for a self-guided tour. Be sure to check out the ceiling mosaic of the Basilica describing the life of Sainte Anne. There will be a Mass in French for anyone wishing to attend. This evening we have an opportunity to explore **Old Quebec City** and get dinner on our own. Fine dining and shopping are an art form in Old Quebec with its European charm and flair.

Day 4

Breakfast is on our own this morning before departing for **St. Joseph's Oratory** for a self-guided tour and lunch on our own. The dome in St. Joseph's is the largest of its kind in the world. Completed in 1967, the Basilica is dedicated to St. Joseph, to whom Saint Andre Bessette credited all his reported miracles. On display in the church museum is Brother Andre's heart, requested as protection for the basilica. This afternoon, we check into Hotel Mortagne in Boucherville, QC, just a few miles from downtown Montreal. Dinner is included this evening at **Vieux Port Steakhouse**. One of the best steakhouses in Montreal, it is located in a century-old structure with old stone walls and cozy fireplaces.

Day 5

Following breakfast on our own this morning, we depart with a local step-on-guide for a **tour of Montreal**. We will drive by many sites such as Mount Royal, Notre Dame Cathedral and Ste-Helene's Island. Lunch is on our own this afternoon in downtown Montreal before arriving at the **St. Kateri Tekakwitha Shrine** for a self guided tour. The Shrine of St. Kateri Tekakwitha is located in the main church of the St. Francis Xavier Mission. In 1972, a sacred chest containing her relics was placed in a marble tomb. St. Kateri's Tomb is located in the church on the right side near the altar. Father Kerner will offer Mass here before returning to our hotel to relax and freshen up. Dinner is on our own this evening as we explore **Old Montreal**. Dating back to new France, Old Montreal and it's old cobblestone streets are lined with buildings dating from the 17th through 19th centuries, grand old French restaurants and shops.

Day 6

Breakfast is on our own this morning before departing for **Niagara Falls, Ontario**. We check into our magnificent hotel just steps from the falls and Niagara Fallsview Casino. Many shops and restaurants surround the hotel for our enjoyment. Dinner is on our own this evening as we enjoy a free night to do as we wish.

Day 7

Today we have a leisurely morning to enjoy Niagara Falls on our own. Check out the falls, try your luck at the casino or just relax. We depart for home early afternoon making stops en route for our comfort and convenience.
