(Matthew 28:19-20). The word "baptize" means "to immerse in, to

immersed in God's name? In the Bible, God's name is identical to God Himself. So, to be baptized into water, using Jesus' formula, is to be

plunged into the life of God. Said another way, it is to die with Jesus and rise with him as a member of his body.


